<input type="checkbox"/>	Check for interactions / contraindications		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Triage Prescription: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coordinate delivery • Notify patient of out-of-pocket cost and co-pay assist programs available 		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Notify clinic the day medication is started		
Follow-Up			
<input type="checkbox"/>	Schedule patient for follow-up visit 2 weeks after starting drug: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pharmacist accompanies provider • Symptom check • Ramp up dosing as needed • Reinforce symptom management plan 		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pharmacy initiates separate, drug-dependent follow-up protocol		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Communication with oncologist when patients are not refilling prescriptions on time.		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Report blood pressure values weekly
